11.09.23 Building each other up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● How can you build others up at home and at school? ● Challenge: Can you think of a time when someone has made a positive impact on you? What did they do? How did it have a positive impact on you?
18.09.23 Trinity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● What does the Trinity mean to you? ● Challenge: Can you tell an adult at home three facts about the Trinity?
25.09.23 Eucharist	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● What is a special meal to you? Why is it so special? ● Challenge: Explain to an adult at home what the Eucharist is and what it means to Christians. Together, share a favourite meal with each other and explain why it means a lot to them. Does this meal remind you of a special event? Does it remind you of a special person?
2.10.23 Humbly serving one another	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Have you ever found it hard to do the right thing? When was the last time you put someone before yourself? What did you do? ● Challenge: Do a random act of kindness this week.
